



Hyde Christmas Decoration Competition Trail



Hyde Parish Support Network thought it would be a lovely idea to brighten up the days leading up to Christmas by holding a decoration trail competition.

To take part you need to decorate a tree, door, window or gate at your property with a Christmas theme – it does not need to be lights – anything that will make people smile and think of Christmas. If you are keen to take part, please remember not to leave any lights on all night to protect the dark skies and keep your neighbours happy – and please ensure that the forest animals are not able to munch the displays.

You need to let the Parish Clerk know that you are taking part and happy for your entry details (location) to be included on a map of the parish available on the Parish website and noticeboards – your entry will be given a number to help voters identify the display.

The competition is to be judged by everyone – details on how to do this will be circulated using the Parish website, Neighbourhood Watch and our noticeboards. Hopefully everyone in the parish can enjoy the displays from a safe social distance.

The competition will start on 1 Dec (closing date for entries Sunday 6th Dec), with judging in the week 12 – 19 Dec (to coincide with Advent)



Winners will be announced, if guidelines permit, at an outdoor event by the cricket pitch on Sun 20 Dec at 3.30pm – hopefully with music and carols.
