Unfortunately we expect there will be a need for more picking after the Easter holidays and over the summer when visitor numbers increase. *A group of residents would like to start a community workshop, based on the men's shed model (see [menssheds.org.uk](http://menssheds.org.uk)) but intend it to be shared by men and women of all ages. Hyde Club have generously volunteered the use of an outbuilding, which after the necessary fundraising - and hopefully - donated equipment, will eventually have tools and materials suitable for various projects e.g repairing, restoring, upcycling items and products. Members will be able to share and learn skills, or just call in for a chat. *Starting in July West Hampshire Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) will be establishing a community based Urgent Treatment Centre (UTC) – the new name for Minor Injury Units – at Lymington hospital, with a satellite hub at Ringwood. The UTC will bring 3 services under one roof, the minor injury unit, the evening and weekend GP appointment hub and the out-of-hours GP services. They will offer routine and urgent appointments bookable through GP practices and NHS 111.*

*PRIDE IN YOUR PARISH responses to our questionnaire showed that the main concern is verge damage, other environmental areas of concern are hedges, ditches, ragwort and dog mess. Speeding and cycle events also featured. Residents want to keep: 1st Village Hall, 2nd School, 3rd Public Houses. A number of residents would like to see a village shop again, and others are keen to plant trees. Full results and your comments and suggestions will be available at our friendly, informal Drop-In, there will also be an opportunity to discuss ideas and future action - and enjoy refreshments.
