The Leader, Cllr Heron and the Chief Executive have asked me to respond to the identical letters you sent to them on 16 March 2016.

I do appreciate, and sympathise with, the difficulties the community of Hyde is facing in relation to telecommunications masts because of the unique value of the landscape within which the village is situated.

However, I am afraid that it is not the role of the County Council, and neither do we have the resources, to become involved in the search for a suitable site. It is down to the telecommunications companies to find and propose site options. If they are on our land we will then consider them, alongside Natural England and the other statutory agencies.

I am sorry I cannot be more helpful at this stage.
